SNAKEBITE FIRST-AID

Do's





Immobilize the victim. Remove belt, jewellery, watch, rings, etc as the bitten area may swell.



If ambulance is delayed, rush to the nearest hospital using any mode of transport.



Transport the victim lying on left side, right leg bent and hand supporting the face. Patient will breathe better and not choke on vomit.



Inform the doctor details of the bite. Antivenom is the only cure.

Don'ts



Do not panic. Snakebite is a treatable condition.



Say no to faith healing. Do not try to kill or capture the snake.



Do not cut or suck the bite area.



Do not tie a tourniquet, don't apply ice or massage the bitten area as it causes further damage.



Do not self medicate or apply any herbs or spices. Nothing helps.

How To Avoid Snakebite



out.

Wear a closed pair Always use a torch of shoes while going at night. Look where you put your hand or foot.



Avoid sleeping on the floor and use a well tucked mosquito net.



Keep home and surroundings clean and clutter free. Control rodent population.
