The art forms included for competitions for this year are: Vocal Music- Classical & **Traditional** folk, Instrumental Music-Classical & Traditional folk, Dance- Classical & Folk, Visual Arts (2-dimensional, 3dimensional and Indigenous Toys)

As part of this effort block level competitions were held on 11th & 12th November 2021. Based on the performance, the selected art forms from the block level have participated in the State Level Competition held on 28th and

29th Nov 2021 through virtual mode.



Altogether **107** participants have showed their talents in all nine art forms through online mode from the Block Project Offices, which were evaluated by a team of external jury members as per the evaluation sheet provided by the NCERT from the State Project Office Shiksha Sadan Port Blair.

The State Level Competitions held through virtual mode have been witnessed by the Secretary (Edn) and State Project Director (SS)/Director (Edn).
