**SOUTH ANDAMAN POLICE SOLVES 2 CASES OF BURGLARY AND
DETECTS GANJA**

Owing to the speedy action by police team of PS Pahargaon, two cases of burglary have been solved, along with recovery of 840 grams of illicit ganja and arrest of two accused persons.

On receiving a complaint of burglary in a house on the night of New Year in which an ATM card was stolen among other articles and subsequent withdrawal of Rs 14,000 from ATM card, the police team headed by SHO Pahargaon, Insp. Sahil Shamsuddin acted swiftly and caught the thief with recovery of ATM card and money. It later come to the light that the accused Hamza was involved in another case of theft at New Wandoor registered at PS Humfrygunj. This information was immediately conveyed to PS Humphrygunj and a team of Police personnel led by Insp. K. Binoj immediately joined the investigating party and the stolen articles i.e. two gold Rings and one Gold chain were recovered.

On further interrogation, the accused Hamza disclosed about possession of contraband Ganja by his accomplice and soon a raiding team of PS Pahargaon consisting of SI P. Jeevan, HC/1156 P. Babu Rao, PC/2408 Bhaskar Rao, PC/2432 Sushil Sarkar of PS Pahargaon headed by Inspr. Sahil Shamsuddin, SHO Pahargaon swung into action and apprehended one E. Enosh, with 840 gms of Illicit Ganja from Bathubasti area. The accused was immediately arrested and a criminal case was registered at PS Pahargaon against the accused.

Due to the strenuous efforts of police team of PS Pahargaon, two burglary cases were solved and 840 grams of contraband/ substance was recovered. The entire operation was directly supervised by Shri. Nishant Gupta, DySP (South Andaman).

The public is requested to share information with Police in full confidence so that such anti-social elements are brought to justice and may pass such information to 03192-232100, 03192-250525 and 9434288763. Also, it is an appeal to general public that they should not write their ATM PIN behind the ATM cards and they should remember it or write it at some other safe place.
