## **Press Note**

## WORLD WETLANDS DAY OBSERVED

World Wetland Day, commemorating the adoption of International Convention on Wetlands was observed in a befitting manner by the Forest Extension & Publicity Division, Department of Environment & Forests, Port Blair with the active participation of students from neighbouring schools on  $02^{nd}$  February 2018. The Day marks the date of the adoption of Convention on Wetlands of international importance especially as Waterfowl habitats held on  $2^{nd}$  February 1971, in Ramsar, Iran.

'Wetlands for a Sustainable Urban Future' was the theme for World Wetlands Day celebrations this year. As part of observance of the day, an awareness programme was arranged in the vicinity of wetlands at Sippighat, South Andaman. About 40 students accompanied by teachers from Govt. Sr. Sec. School Bathubasti, Govt. Sr. Sec. School Garacharma and Govt. Sec. School Dairy Farm, Port Blair were taken on a study tour to the wetland areas of Sippighat for creating greater awareness and wide publicity on wetland conservation. During the programme, the students were explained about the importance of wetlands followed by bird watching under the guidance of Dr. C. Sivaperuman, Scientist-D, Officer-Incharge, Zoological Survey of India, Port Blair. The students identified about 15 wetland birds and migratory birds in the area under his guidance using long range telescopes and other equipments. The students also visited nearby mangrove habitats and identified many mangrove species.

Earlier, the students were briefed on the importance of wetlands by Shri. Joju. P. Alappatt, Divisional Forest Officer, Forest Extension & Publicity Division. During his speech on the importance of wetlands, he highlighted the role of wetlands including mangroves and its biodiversity values and asked the students to come forward in protecting and conserving wetlands and its biodiversity. He elaborated the importance of mangroves of the islands and appealed the student community to extend their full support to the Forest Department in conserving this unique habitats. The Range Officer, Forest Extension & Publicity Division, Port Blair, Shri S K Roy along with other staff of the Division guided the students during the entire programme.
