

PRESS NOTE

It is observed that on several instances that the fishermen of these Islands violate the Provisions of Andaman & Nicobar Islands Marine Fishing Rules. Few fishermen are also found venturing into the Prevention of Aboriginal Tribes (PAT) Regulated areas. It is hereby brought to the notice of all Fishers to abide by the Provisions of Andaman & Nicobar Islands Marine Fishing Rules. The Non Motorized and Motorized Non Mechanical Boats (with engines of 30HP or less) to fish only in Zone A i.e. from 0 to 6 Nautical Miles from the appropriate Base line and Motorized Mechanical fishing boats to fish only in Zone B i.e. 6 to 12 Nautical miles. Any fishers found violating the above Rules, action will be taken as per the Provisions of the Andaman and Nicobar Marine Fishing Regulation and Rules framed thereunder.
