**05 DAYS COURSE ON "INVESTIGATION OF MURDER/HOMICIDE CASES"**

The main objective of the course is to improve the investigation skills of the officers in murder/homicide cases and to impart knowledge regarding crime scene management and importance of protection of evidentiary material in Murder/Homicide cases.
