TWO DAYS SHORT COURSE ON "FORENSIC SCIENCE, DNA PROFILING IN CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION, COLLECTION OF FINGER PRINT AND EVIDENCE AT CRIME SCENE" AT PTS PROTHRAPUR FROM 08/06/18 TO 09/06/18

The Police Training School, Prothrapur, A & N Islands has organized two days course on "Forensic Science, DNA profiling in Criminal Investigation, Collection of Finger Print and Evidence at Crime Scene" from 08/06/2018 to 09/06/2018 for in-service Police personnel from the rank of Constables to Inspector under the overall supervision of Smti. Usha Rangnani, IPS, Principal, PTS, Prothrapur. The main objective of the course is to improve the investigation skills of Police personnel in criminal cases and to impart knowledge of crime scene management and importance of the protection of evidentiary material in criminal cases. The course was inaugurated by Shri. R.K. Sharma, Inspector Admn., PTS. During the course Dr. Yogesh, Senior Scientific Officer, Shri. Shivendra Pratap Singh, Shri. P. Patil, Shri.
