As the part of programme on Gandhi Jayanthi Week, today on 04th October 2018, at ANCOL, Dr. N. Francis Xavier, Principal, JNRM, gave a small talk entitled "Gandhi as an Immigrant". He stated that Gandhiji's immigration to Africa, staying there for 21 yrs., experiencing the colour discrimination, many other atrocities, and injustice, towards the Indians in Africa.
