## <u>Vice Chancellor - Pondicherry University Visits' ANCOL on 29 Dec 2018</u>

Hon'ble Prof. Gurmeet Singh, Vice Chancellor, Pondicherry University visited Andaman College, Chakkargaon on 29h December 2018, on Official Visit. He inspected the campus and addressed the gathering at Conference Hall, ANCOL. He planted Coconut Sapling in ANCOL premises.

Shri. D. Manikandan, IAS – Secretary (Education) was present and graced the occasion. Secretary (Edn.) in his address, briefed about the Digi - Locker & Digital Admission facility being introduced in all colleges of these islands. He further stated that the islands will have its own Deemed University very soon, and in the month of January, a Job Mela will be organized for the educated youth of the islands. He further said that the MHRD / UGC – New Delhi introduced SWAYAM Portal for MOOCs, Short Term, Add On Courses for Employment Purpose. He urged the faculties and students to Register themselves and take advantage of these courses.
