	5. Nutrition & health Education	This service is being extended to enhance the mother's awareness about basic health, child needs and capacity to look after the children.	
	6. Pre-school Education	One hour non-formal education is given to the children of 3-6 years in Aganwadi Centres to improve their physical, emotional, social and intellectual development.
