Revenue Receipts

Statement below indicates the overall position of revenue receipts of Andaman and Nicobar Administration.

Andaman and Nicobar Administration's revenue receipts comprise of tax and non-tax receipts. The administration's total revenue receipt during 2007-08 was Rs.14314.82 Lakhs with a growth of 14.22% over the previous year. The highest growth in revenue realization in all the five previous years in comparison to the previous years was during the year 2006-07 with a growth of 17.95%. There was a decrease in realization of revenue receipts during the Year 2004-05 due to lesser realization of non-tax revenue receipts.

Tax Revenue

Andaman & Nicobar Administration's Tax Revenue consists of Land Revenue, Stamps and Registration Fees, State Excise, Tax on Vehicles etc. The tax revenue estimates for the year 2007-08 was Rs.2142.00 Lakhs while the Tax revenue realization was Rs.2228.97 Lakhs which was higher than

estimated. The tax revenue for 2007-08 represented 15.57% of the total revenue receipts during that year. The tax revenue realization has shown a consistent increase during the last five years. During the last five years the higher growth in tax revenue in comparison to the previous years was during the year 2006-07 with a growth of 29.38% and realizing Rs.2021.14 Lakhs.

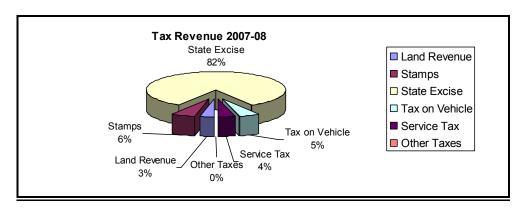
State Excise is the major source of tax revenue with collection to the tune of Rs.1839.14 Lakhs in 2007-08 which was over 82% of total tax revenue for that year. State Excise has a share of more than 80% of the total tax revenue receipts of this administration.

Land Revenue, Stamps & Registration Fees and Tax on Vehicles are other main items of Tax Revenue of this Administration. Though Land revenue collection decreased by 52% in 2007-08 as compared to collection in 2006-07, stamps & registration fees collection increased by 71.71% and tax on vehicles also increased by 13.18%.

Non-Tax Revenue

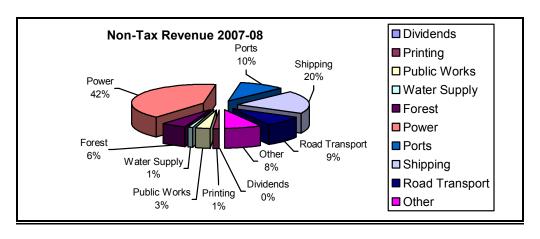
Andaman & Nicobar Administration's Non-Tax Revenue comprises of dividends and profits, public works receipts, power receipts etc. Non-tax revenue receipts consists the major portion of the administration's total revenue receipts. During the year 2007-08 the non-tax revenue realization was at Rs.12085.85 lakhs which constituted 84.43% of the total revenue receipts for that year and 101.92% of the non-tax revenue estimates.

Power sector is the highest source of non-tax revenue receipts. During the last five years, realization under the power sector has been the highest which constituted not less than 40% among all other non-tax revenue receipts. Shipping is the next highest source of non-tax revenue followed by Ports and Light Houses.

Revenue Expenditure

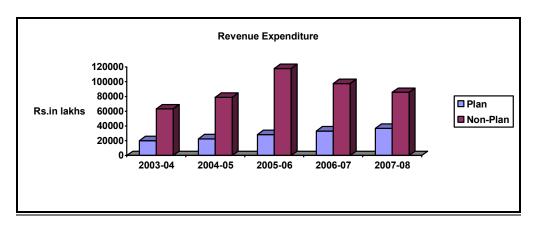

Revenue Expenditure of Andaman and Nicobar Administration consists of Salary and other miscellaneous expenditure. Out of the total revenue expenditure, majority expenditure was under non-plan. The non-plan expenditure during the year 2007-08 was Rs.85741.99 Lakhs which stood at 69% of the total revenue expenditure. During the year 2007-08 the total revenue expenditure was 98.53% of the final grant of revenue section. The revenue estimates for the year 2007-08 was Rs.124610.84 Lakhs while the revenue expenditure amounted to Rs.122774.47 lakhs.

Central Grants

Grant-in-Aid from various Central Ministries is available to Andaman & Nicobar Administration in the form of centrally sponsored schemes. Various Ministries authorize this administration for implementing various centrally sponsored schemes in these islands. During the year 2007-08 an amount of Rs.2008.84 lakhs was received towards centrally sponsored schemes by this administration and expenditure incurred was Rs.1905.07 lakhs which was about 94.83% of the authorised amount.

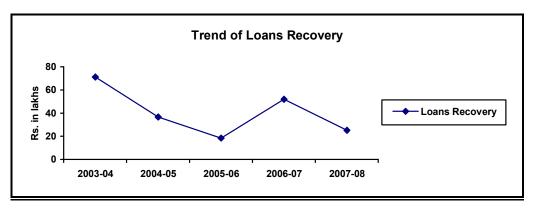

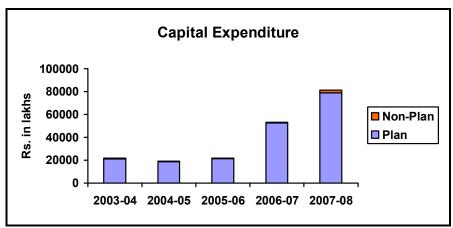

The capital expenditure estimates for the year 2007-08 was Rs.81790 Lakhs while the total capital expenditure amounted to Rs.81392.50 lakhs.
