

MAHILA SHAKTI KENDRA

- To promote community participation through involvement of student volunteers for empowerment of rural women. The new scheme is envisaged to work at National, State and District Levels. GoI has sanctioned one District Level Centre for Women (DLCW) along with funds for Nicobar District (Beti Bachao Beti Padhao District) for implementation of MSK Scheme during the current year.
- Deputy Commissioner has been requested to recruit 1 District Coordinator and 2 Project Coordinators in Nicobar District for District level Centre for Women (DLCW).
- To establish at least 20 Mahila Shakti Kendras in Nicobar District
- No Block Level component is sanctioned for Nicobar District.
- Ministry has released an amount of Rs. 10.90 lakh for implementation of Mahila Shakti Kendra
- Fund has been allotted to Nicobar District for an amount of Rs. 4.95 lakh
